RE: 2025 TREEDC Membership information

Dear TREEDC Supporter:

Happy New Year! 2024 was another very productive year for the 108 mayors and 30 universities and colleges of the Tennessee Renewable Energy & Economic Development Council (TREEDC,) a 501 c (3) organization formed in 2008. TREEDC worked diligently to keep our members informed with newsletters, grant announcements, site visits, introductions, forums and phone calls. We also assisted several energy startups with marketing and outreach of their products. During 2024, TREEDC worked with the Energy Services Coalition (ESC) to help match local community energy needs with appropriate renewable energy technologies to reduce costs and emissions. TREEDC also helped establish a state revolving loan fund to fund matching grant dollars for green infrastructure. We also established a technical assistance program with ESC to help make state facilities more energy efficient. In 2025, TREEDC is poised to assist our members with the Tennessee Solar For All Program which will be administered by TREEDC Member Tennessee Department of Environment & Conservation (TDEC) Office of Energy Programs.

During 2024, TREEDC hosted an annual conference and awards program with Tennessee Tech University. We also worked with various local governments on determining the feasibility of streetlight conversions to LED. TREEDC also partnered with the University of Tennessee MTAS with its Rural Community Development Initiative Program to strengthen rural economies through outreach and resiliency. TREEDC worked with Cooley Public Strategies to inform the Tennessee General Assembly about the economic and environmental benefits of green stormwater infrastructure for the Protect Tennessee program. We also partnered with Tennessee Environmental Council (TEC) with its tree planting program. TREEDC West Tennessee Coordinator Bolivar Mayor Julian McTizic worked closely with development of the Ford Motor Company Electric Truck Manufacturing plant in West Tennessee. We also assisted the Tennessee Municipal League (TML) and MTAS with informational workshops for its members.

2025 promises to be another exciting year. Thanks to our 16 years of cultivating and building relationships among our clean energy stakeholders, we will continue working closely with our members to promote renewable energy with economic development.
